Every year, the French Government, through their Cultural Services in the U.S., offers 3 week grants in France, to qualified Primary and Secondary Schools French Teachers who would like to improve their language skills and enhance their knowledge of French culture.

#### ABOUT THE GRANT AND THE TRAINING

What is covered :

- Subscription and training fees for 3 weeks
- Round-trip train ticket from Paris to the training center
- Part of the costs for lodging and food

The grant does not cover the airfare USA/France.

Dates : July, 3 to July, 21,2006 (3 weeks).

#### Destinations offered :

Please note that the Embassy might not be able to allocate the candidate's first choice.

#### Candidates selected by the cultural services :

- **Besançon** (about 80 hours of training)
- Brest (75 hours of training)
- Nantes (60 hours of training)

#### Candidates selected by AATF only :

- Paris (about 65 hours of training)

<u>Theme</u> : Intensive study of French linguistics, teaching French and modern French culture through writing, theatre, the movies...

#### ELIGIBILITY

Full-time teachers in accredited schools who :

- are US Citizen or Permanent Resident (French citizens are not allowed to apply)
- have working knowledge of French
- are assigned to teach the French language and/or French Culture in grades K-12
- wish to strengthen their French language skills and enhance their knowledge of French culture
- have not received a grant from the French Government for the last 3 years
